## **LogistiCare Awarded \$44 Million Nevada Medicaid Transportation Contract**

ATLANTA and LAS VEGAS -- LogistiCare Solutions, LLC, has been awarded another four-year contract by the state of Nevada's Department of Health Care and Finance Policy (DHCFP) to continue to provide Non-Emergency Medical Transportation services (NEMT) for Nevada's 169,000 Medicaid recipients.

"The Division of Health Care Financing & Policy (DHCFP) strives to contract for 'best value' services that serve the needs of Nevada's Medicaid & Nevada Checkup recipients. The award was made after a competitive bid process and is valued at approximately \$44,000,000. The new contract period began October 1, 2007.
