LogistiCare Receives Award Notice from the State of Oklahoma for \$24 Million Transportation Contract

ATLANTA and OKLAHOMA CITY (11/15/07) LogistiCare Solutions, LLC has received an award notice from the Oklahoma Department of Central Services to manage the state's SoonerCare (Medicaid) Non Emergency Transportation (NET) program, known as SoonerRide. The annual value of the contract is approximately \$24.0 million. The award is subject to finalized contracts and various processing procedures. The new contract is expected to take effect January 1, 2008 and has five one-year renewal options. SoonerRide currently serves over 519,000 SoonerCare recipients statewide and provides over 700,000 medical trips every year.

LogistiCare has managed the SoonerRide program since August 2003, delivering NET services through a statewide network of 37 local transportation providers. LogistiCare operates a central business office in the Oklahoma City office, and a regional office in Tulsa. Under the new contract, the number of Oklahoma-based LogistiCare staff working will increase from 15 to 30 as the program call center function is moved to the Oklahoma City location.

“We are very excited to continue our partnership with the state of Oklahoma,” said John Shermyen, LogistiCare's CEO. “We are gratified that OHCA values our contributions to the SoonerRide program, and we look forward to five more years of providing quality SoonerRide service for the people of Oklahoma.”

On November 6, 2007, The Providence Service Corporation (Nasdaq: PRSC) signed a definitive merger agreement to acquire 100% of the outstanding stock of Charter LCI Corporation, the holding company of LogistiCare, Inc. The transaction is expected to close prior to the end of the calendar year, subject to the satisfaction of customary closing conditions, including Hart-Scott-Rodino clearance. The renewal of the contract announced in this release was contemplated when previous guidance was given.
